Modesto City Schools is made up of an elementary school district (grades K-8) and a high school district (grades 9-12). Both are governed by a single, seven-member Board of Education elected at large from within the high school district attendance area – approximately 250 square miles – for four-year terms of office.

There are 22 elementary schools (grades K-6), four junior high schools (grades 7-8), seven comprehensive high schools (grades 9-12), and an extensive alternative education program within Modesto City Schools. Enrollment for the 2014-2015 school year is expected to reach approximately 30,000 students.

Modesto City Schools is committed to the educational achievement of every student, regardless of his or her background or circumstance. Staff collaborate to prepare students for their next steps after graduation, whether it be college, career or military service.
